Essay Thought: the Future – César stated in a 1984 speech that:

"...Hispanics across California and the nation who don't work in agriculture are better off today because of what the farm workers taught people about organization, about pride and strength, about seizing control over their own lives.

Tens of thousands of the children and grandchildren of farm workers and the children and grandchildren of poor Hispanics are moving out of the fields and out of the barrios--and into the professions and into business and into politics. And that movement cannot be reversed!"

Essay Topic:

Question: If you come from a farmworker family, tell us what you have done to help your family succeed in the future. If you are not from a farmworker family, tell us what you, as an individual, can do to help farmworkers and their families succeed in the future (for example in education, business, and politics etc.).

Guidelines: Write a *two-page, typed and double-spaced* essay answering all the questions and ideas presented. Be sure to develop your story in a clear and concise manner. Include your name, address, phone number and school name on the first page of each essay, along with this attached and completed application.
